### **Competitive Section**

### **Competitive Clubman of the Year - Motivation Cup**

This is the main championship and brings together points from the competitive categories which are added together to give an overall score.

# **Autosolo Cup [Davis Cup]**

Presented to the member who scores the most amount of points in the Open Autosolo championship.

## Oxford Motor Club Autosolo Cup [Mark Donaldson Trophy]

Presented to the member who scores the most combined points on Oxford MC Autosolos.

### **Expert Navigator Cup [Wilfred Matthews Cup]**

Presented to the best Expert Navigator on Motorsport UK Permitted Road Rally Events.

# **Club Navigator Cup [Wootten Trophy]**

Presented to the best *Oxford Motor Club* navigator for events not covered in other sections i.e., PCA, Navex, Scatters and Treasure Hunts etc.

If a nominated event does not run a suitable alternative will be added by the Points Co-Ordinator.

### **Other Motorsport Events**

Other Motorsport UK permitted events such as Scatters, Navex's Scenic Drives, Treasure Hunts, Sprints, Circuit Racing, Karting, Hill Climb etc are eligible.

Scoring – Five best scores from seven events.

There will be one award for overall top driver and navigator.

Points will count towards the Motivation Cup.

### **Non-Competitive Section**

There will be awards for individual categories and all points count towards the following trophies.

# Non-Competitive Clubman of the Year - Macclesfield Cup

This is the main club championship and brings together points from the other non-competitive categories which are added together to give an overall score.

# Marshal of the Year - Jubilee Cup

Presented to the member who has attained the most points marshalling on Motorsport UK permitted events. If you are competing on an event you cannot claim marshalling points, e.g. Autosolo.

20 points for marshalling on *Oxford Motor Club* events, 5 points for out of club events

# **Lady Member of the Year - Boanerges Cup**

Presented to the lady member who has scored the highest amount of points in all categories.

# Newcomer of the Year - Batchelor Cup

Presented to the person who has joined the *Oxford Motor Club* during the previous 15 months [01/10 – 31/12] not having been a previous member and having scored the highest number of points in all categories.

# **Under 21 Award**

Presented to the member aged under 21 at the end of the claim year scoring the highest amount of points in all categories.

Contenders Date of Birth must be notified to championship points collator.

### **Rob Smith Trophy**

Presented to the member aged under 25 at the end of the claim year who in the opinion of the Committee has best represented *Oxford Motor Club* and Motorsport during the year. Contenders Date of Birth must be notified to championship points collator.

### **Other Categories**

Points awarded in these following categories also count towards the Macclesfield Cup.

### **Magazine Articles**

**20 points** per Club event / related articles, **10 points** for all others.

### **Organisers Points**

Points will be awarded to any club member involved in organising but not competing on an *Oxford Motor Club* activity or event.

20 points per day will be awarded for In-Club events only.

#### **Other Events / Activities**

Covering all occasions and activities not included in other sections. Points will be awarded to any club member involved in any non-competitive *Oxford Motor Club* activity or event.

**20 points** per day will be awarded for **In-Club** events only.

# **Championship Rules**

**Oxford Motor Club** will run several club orientated championships as listed below and the following rules will apply.

The Championship year runs from January 1<sup>st</sup> until December 31<sup>st</sup> and points will be allocated from the date of membership of the club,

You have to be a current **full** or **family** member of **Oxford Motor Club** to score points in the championship.

# **Competitive Events**

During the year you <u>must</u> actively support at least <u>one</u> in-club activity or event to be eligible for an award in the championship.

There will be awards for individual competitions and all points count towards the above trophies.

To score full points competitors must enter events as **Oxford Motor Club** members or **Oxford Motor Club** MUST be an invited Club otherwise only start points will be awarded.

It would be appreciated if any vehicle entering a competition can display an Oxford Motor Club sticker – these are freely available from the club.

Details of the event regulations, entry list and results are required.

Competition points are scored as follows;

5 Start points plus position points against fellow Oxford Motor Club members.

**Oxford Motor Club** competitors who organise an event will be awarded **20 points** in lieu of place points.

## **Non-Competitive Events**

During the year you <u>must</u> actively support at least <u>one</u> in-club activity or event to be eligible for an award in the championship.

#### General

All points must be claimed by **January 7**<sup>th</sup>. Points not claimed by this date will be <u>invalid</u> and <u>not added</u> to the championship point's tables.

All claims must be accurate and submitted in accordance with the claim form and time scale.

Any missed information will result in only start / minimum points being awarded.

#### Activities eligible for points and qualifying for an award

- Organising a Club event / activity
- Entering a Club event / activity
- Marshalling on a Club event / activity
- Helping Set Up or Take Down a Club event / activity
- Attending the AGM or an EGM,
- Representing the Club at outside events eg Club Stand or Motorsport UK Regional Association meetings,
- Submitting a current article for the Club magazine
- Attending a Club social ACTIVITY e.g. visits, quiz or treasure hunt,

# Activities <u>not</u> eligible for points:

- Attending Committee meetings
- Attending social evenings [unless organising or taking part in an activity i.e. visits, quiz or treasure hunt]
- Attending out-of-club social events.

While every endeavour is made to accurately record your points, the Points Collator is **not** responsible for sourcing member's activities or any unclaimed points – it is your responsibility to claim.
